The World of women – Tanzania gives a voice to Tanzanian women whose inspiring life journeys take readers to four prime tourist destinations in the country. This is first volume of the collection and is published in both English and French.

- Insights into the geographical, economic and cultural contexts of life in Tanzania
- Portraits of women who tell the story of their daily life and aspirations
